2. Will all 100 learners undergo training through all the unit standards?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yes
3. Is Sworn affidavit allowed/accepted for BBBEE?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yes
4. What does CATHSSETA mean by learners with difficulties?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learners with special needs
5. CATHSSETA requires 10% of learner assessments moderated whereas ETDP requires 25% which will be acceptable?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Since the programme is ETDP SETA accredited please adhere to ETDP SETA rules in this regard
6. Accreditation for providers is up to March 2018 and this was based on the SETA landscape CATHSSETA requires accreditation for the full duration of the programme will this not disadvantage the providers?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CATHSSETA will accept accreditation ending in March 2018 however the provider must apply for re-accreditation 6 months before the current accreditation lapses
