Section 9 of the Skills Development Act No. 97 of 1998 as amended (SDA) establishes the Sector Education Training Authorities (SETAs) for each national economic sector to facilitate skills development. Section 11 of the SDA provides for the appointment of the Members of the Board of each SETA, with the powers vested in the Minister of Higher Education, Science and Innovation.

The Composition of the Board of each SETA is drawn from the following constituencies:

- Organised Employer;
- Organised Labour; and
- Community Organisations/Professional Bodies/Government Institutions.

Vacancies on the Board have arisen in the CATHSSETA Board and must be filled by members drawn from the constituencies: Community Organisation and Organised Labour. In terms of the Approved Constitution of the CATHSSETA of 2019 which is promulgated per Section 13 of the SDA, when a vacancy arises on the Board, a replacement must come from the same constituency.

A call is hereby made to nominate a candidate(s), especially from the following subsectors:

- Community Organisation Constituency - Arts, Culture and Heritage subsector;
- Organised Labour Constituency – Hospitality or Tourism or Travel Services.
