Discretionary Grant application forms, along with the Discretionary Grant application procedures and related information are accessible on the CATHSSETA website, www.cathsseta.org.za.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES: • Applications should reach CATHSSETA no later than 31 July 2016. The online portal will be closed at 23h59, and no applications will be accepted after the deadline. • Only applications that comply with and support the CATHSSETA Sector Scarce and Critical Skills reflected above and in the CATHSSETA Discretionary Grants policy will be considered. • Online applications should be properly completed and ALL required supporting documents must be uploaded. • Incomplete applications will not be considered. • Bursary applications are only available for undergraduate qualifications. • Employers applying for Work Integrated Learning should recruit learners from TVET Colleges. • Employers applying for Internships should recruit learners from public education & training institutions (universities & universities of technology). • It is the responsibility of applicants to familiarise themselves with CATHSSETA's Discretionary Grants Policy. • Upon submitting your application form, you will receive an automated response containing a DG reference number.
