



### **Updating of training provider contact details on the SETA Management System**

The Culture, Arts, Tourism, Hospitality and Sports Sector Education and Training Authority (CATHSSETA), is a statutory body established in terms of the Skills Development Act, No. 97 of 1998, to promote and facilitate the delivery of education, training and development initiatives in order to enhance the skills profile of its sectorial stakeholders.

The functions of the ETQA are governed by the ETQA Regulation R1127, to act as quality assuring bodies within the SETAs. Under the ETQA Regulations, roles and responsibilities of the ETQA include

- Accredit providers for specific standards or qualifications
- Promote quality amongst providers
- Monitor provision by constituent providers
- Evaluate assessments and moderation amongst providers
- Register Assessors
- Take responsibility for the certification of learners
- Maintain a database acceptable to the Authority
- Submit reports to the Authority

The ETQA department has observed that a number of training providers have changed their contact details and persons. In order to ensure that communication reaches the correct individuals, we require updated contact details.
