Application guidelines: • Applications should reach CATHSSETA by no later than 31 January 2019. The online portal will be closed at 23:59. No applications will be accepted after the deadline • Applications aligned to the CATHSSETA Occupational and Skills Gaps reflected above and in the CATHSSETA Discretionary Grants policy will be given preference • Online applications should be properly completed and ALL required supporting documents must be uploaded (please refer to the application guidelines available on our website for required documentation) • Incomplete applications will not be considered • Levy and non-levy paying employers applying for Work Integrated Learning NCV Level 4 & Nated 6 should recruit learners from TVET Colleges (preference will be given to public TVET Colleges) • Levy and non-levy paying employers applying for Internships should recruit learners from higher education & training institutions (preference will be given to Public Universities and Universities of Technology) • Levy paying employers applying must be up to date with their levies and mandatory grants • It is the responsibility of applicants to familiarise themselves with CATHSSETA's Discretionary Grants Policy • Upon submitting your application form, you will receive an automated response containing a Discretionary Grants reference number.
