

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO SERVE ON THE CATHSSETA ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY BOARD, 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2025



Persons will be appointed by the Minister of Higher Education Science and Technology to serve on the Accounting Authority of the Culture, Arts, Tourism, Hospitality and Sports Sector Education and Training Authority (CATHSSETA) for the period 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2025.

The CATHSSETA is a Schedule 3 public entity established in terms of Section 9(1) of the Skills Development Act, No 97 of 1998. CATHSSETA's mandate is to facilitate skills development in the following subsectors: Culture, Arts and Heritage; Tourism and Travel Services; Hospitality; Gaming and Lotteries; Conservation; and Sport, Recreation and Fitness. To address this, the Skills Development Act directs CATHSSETA to develop the Sector Skills Plan and implement various learning programmes in support thereof.

The Minister of Higher Education Science and Technology invites nominations from relevant organised labour and organised employers, government departments, professional bodies, community organisations and bargaining council organisations within the CATHSSETA scope to submit nominations of qualified persons to serve as additional members on the CATHSSETA Board. The Minister will consider candidates with proven experience in fostering good governance, who demonstrate understanding of the legislative and policy framework applicable to CATHSSETA as well as government policies and plans applicable to the subsectors referred to above.

In line with the Board gender balance representation requirements, nominations from women candidates are strongly encouraged.

Nominated representatives from the relevant constituency organisations should be competent in one or more of the following disciplines:

- Application of corporate governance strategy and ethics
- Financial management, auditing and legal
- Human resource development, education, training and skills development
- Quality assurance of learning provision
- Skills development legislation and the National Skills Development Plan (NSDP)
- The Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) and Regulations.

Nominations must be made on the prescribed nomination form, obtainable from www.cathsseta.org.za and must contain a full motivation, the full name and address of the candidate, a signed nomination form and acceptance of the nomination by the nominee, a certified copy of an ID, a Curriculum Vitae, certified copies of qualifications of the nominee and all compulsory forms as provided on the website.

Candidates will be subjected to probity checks (criminal and civil records, reference checks, qualification and experience verification, integrity checks, etc).
